MacMillan Coffee Morning Friday 25th September 2026

Dear Parents/Carers

We would like to inform you about an upcoming event in the school calendar, Macmillan Coffee Morning. This is an event Knights Templar has proudly taken part in since 2015, and as of last year has seen it return to its former glory.

As I am sure you are aware 1 in 2 people will receive a cancer diagnoses, which means cancer is likely to have impacted all of our lives. Macmillan is an exceptional charity which offers support physically, financially and emotionally for those affected by cancer and their annual coffee mornings create a vital revenue for continuing their support. In addition, this is a great event for students to get involved in to build a sense of community, be a part of something bigger than Knights Templar and gives an opportunity for the school community to reflect and offer support to those around them. Furthermore, we will be asking the whole school to bring in a cake or baked good to share with their fellow students as a way of raising money for Macmillan.

The event will take place on Friday 25th September, with the main event happening at break time. We kindly ask that prior to this event, and so your child can enjoy a piece of cake at break time, that a donation is made using this [Just Giving](#) link. We are asking for donations of £1 if bringing in a cake or baked good to share or £2 if not. This event is only possible with the support of parents/carers, students and staff who bring in a cake or a baked good to be distributed during break time. So, we would greatly appreciate your support in this matter.

If your child would like to donate a cake to Macmillan Coffee Morning we would encourage the following steps to be taken. Firstly, complete the [google form](#) to indicate that your child will be bringing in a cake or baked good on the day. The form will ask for your child's name, house and list of ingredients. It is important that anything brought into school for this event, and to ensure everyone can enjoy the day, that any cakes or baked goods **do not** include nuts, blackcurrant, kiwi, mango or oats. Then, get baking! Students can bring in their baked goods before form to the canteen on Friday Morning where they will be sorted ready to be distributed at break time.

As in previous years, this event contributes to the House competition and House points will be given out for taking part in the event, making a cake or baked good and the Showstopper competition. Every cake or baked good brought in on 25th September could be in with a chance of winning the Showstopper competition, as the Sixth form will shortlist the baked goods and an expert staff panel will select a winner. Any cake or baked good shortlisted will be put into a raffle which students and staff can buy tickets for and have a chance of winning some of the best cakes made for the day. If students wish to purchase raffle tickets, they will need to bring in £1 for every strip they wish to purchase. The money raised by the Showstopper raffle will also be donated to Macmillan.
